

Register here to Race the Bend!

Red Deer Nordic and Parkland Cross Country Ski Club along with Nordiq Alberta, welcome you to River Bend Recreation Area located on the meeting place of Treaty 6 and Treaty 7 regions. This area is the traditional Indigenous territory of the Niisitapi, the Tsuut'ina, Stoney Nakoda, Cree, Saulteaux and Métis peoples. Let's join in the spirit of unity for an action-packed weekend of skiing, camaraderie, competition and fun.

Race Schedule (times subject to change):

FRIDAY, FEB 2 - Training and Friday Night Lights

2:00 - 5:00 PM - OFFICIAL TRAINING

Note that the course direction of travel will be reversed at 5pm to prepare for the Friday Night Lights event; all trails will be treated as two-way. Controllers will be on course to guide athletes.

6:30 PM - Friday Night Lights Starts - Meet at Discovery Canyon Shelter

Friday Night Lights is a fun, festival-like event under the lights to celebrate the end of a great season. There are events for all ages and skill levels just for fun!

- Children up to 9 will have the chance to participate in an exciting modified skills course.
- Anyone 10 and over (U12-U16) is invited to pick a relay partner to race the fast and
 exciting relay course. The teams do not have to be the same gender, age or club. If you
 do not have a friend to ski with, we will find you one!
- Skiers 16 and over (U18 and above) can ski two laps of our 1.75 km course. Start in Discovery Canyon, racing up through the stadium area and down through the start/finish to continue into the lower hills.

6:30 start - U8 - U10 modified skills course

6:45 start - U12 - U16 relay freestyle 2 x 1.75km

7:30 start - U18 and older individual freestyle 3.5 km

• *** Special prizes will be awarded to the <u>club with the most team spirit</u> (this might be an official ski club or a group of 5 or more with the best theme, spirit and enthusiasm), and to a select few racers with the best costumes.

Saturday will be an Individual Start with racers for all but the U12 and U14 categories, seeded based on the Nordiq Alberta Technical Package with the fastest skiers starting last. See the table below for Seeding order.

U12 and U14 categories will ski a ladder sprint, classic technique. Results from the Qualifier will be used to seed the wave pursuit on Sunday.

SUNDAY, FEB 4 - Alberta Cup 8

8:30 AM - SIT SKI START

9:00 AM - FREESTYLE PURSUIT START

Sunday will be a standard Pursuit Start for all U16 and older, with the top racers starting at intervals equal to their time behind the first finisher of Saturday's race. A wave start will be determined at a fixed time behind the lead skier. This wave will also include all starters without a time recorded from Saturday. The Chief of Competition, in consultation with the Jury, will be responsible for determining the wave time based on Saturday's results and are estimated at three (3) to five (5) minutes behind the leaders for each start group.

The U12 and U14 will race a wave Pursuit, with 1 to 6 racers having similar qualifying times on Saturday being placed in each wave. Waves will be 2 or 3 minutes apart, and winners will be determined by the fastest time of completion (rather than 1st across the line).

U8 & U10 Masters and Recreational categories will be participating in a MASS START.

Categories skiing the same distance will be intermingled for this start. For example, U18 M/W, U20 M/W, Open M/W will be seeded based on their time behind the fastest skier of all three categories.

For both weekend days we invite Non-Binary athletes to compete in our Recreational category and to join the fun with everyone on Friday.

Coaches:

Coaches are allowed on foot on the course during the race but not in the stadium. Please <u>register</u>, at no cost, to provide us with your contact information. See the QR code below for access to the **AB Cup 2023/24 Coaches** WhatsApp chat group through which we will be doing the bulk of our communication. Register again as a racer to race in Friday Night Lights!

Licences:

All competitors skiing in U14 and older categories must have at least one of the following licenses:

- Nordig Canada Race License (U16+)
- Nordig Canada Associate License (foreign racers who do not belong to a NC club)
- Nordiq Canada Development License (U14 and under if CPL points desired see NC website)
- Nordiq Canada Event License (U14+) This \$6 license was formerly the Supporting Member Day License (SMDL) and is charged automatically during registration if no other license number is supplied.

For Saturday and Sunday races, cross-country ski club athletes U12 category and younger do not require a license of any type, but do require a valid club membership.

All competitors, regardless of age or other Nordiq Canada race licenses held, will have to pay the new Tier 3 event license of \$3 only for the Friday Night Lights event. See Nordiq Canada's explanation of Tier 3 licensing here.

Any athlete, of any age, from other Nordic disciplines including Biathlon or Nordic Combined, that are not members of a Nordiq Alberta club, must have a valid Nordiq Canada Race or Event license to compete.

Associate License for non-Canadian Skiers: For non-Canadian skiers, an Associate License may be obtained through Nordiq Canada for eligibility in all sanctioned competitions in Canada. The results of skiers with Associate Licenses will be included in the Canada Point List calculation and used for seeding purposes. For more information, visit the Nordiq Canada website.

If you do not have a current FIS, Nordiq Canada, or Nordiq Canada Associate Member Licence and are registering in U14+ categories, a daily fee will be automatically added for an Event License (formerly SMDL)

Please make sure you have renewed/purchased your license(s) for this year <u>HERE</u> prior to registering.

Points:

**Alberta Cup 8 <u>Points</u> for Pursuits will be assigned based on the TIME, not placings across the finish line. <u>Awards</u> will be distributed based on finish placing at finish line for all but U12 and U14 for which awards will be based on finishing time.

Selection:

This competition is part of the AB Cup provincial race series. It also serves as a selection event for: Alberta Ski Team (AST - criteria <u>HERE</u>) and Alberta Development Ski Team (ADST - criteria <u>HERE</u>)

Alberta Cup Wax Protocol

Alberta Cup Wax Protocol Nordic Alberta respectfully requests all coaches, athletes, wax technicians, and parents to abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for identified races taking place in Alberta. This also applies to coaches, athletes, wax technicians, and parents traveling to Alberta from out-of-province or out-of-country.

Waxing protocol:

- Structure tools ARE permitted.
- Non-fluoro (NF) waxes ARE permitted.
- Fluorinated waxes or tuning products containing fluorine liquid are NOT permitted at Alberta Cups for ALL age categories. This includes all types of fluorinated glide wax (e.g., LF, HF, block, powder, liquid, or kick wax).

Occasionally an Alberta Cup may be run in conjunction with a FIS Cup, NorAm, or other FIS sanctioned event. For more information on the Nordiq Canada Fluoro Policy, click here: https://nordiqcanada.ca/coaches-and-wax-techs/wax-techs/wax-tech-resources/
