REGISTRATION

Registration and fee payment is online at <u>Zone4</u>. Coaches MUST register on Zone4 (no fee). Racers and coaches must check the confirmation list on Zone4 as soon as possible after completing registration to ensure skiers are registered in the correct categories. Snow Enhancement Fee: This year, we will be collecting a Snow Enhancement Fee of \$5 for U14 and older and \$2.50 for U12 and younger that will be used to support our vision for the future of cross-country skiing in Central Alberta. Your contribution will support the Red Deer Nordic Ski Club when collaborating with the City of Red Deer to implement snow-making capabilities at River Bend. In the face of climate change, this initiative will ensure consistent, high-quality snow conditions for youth programming, community recreation, and athlete training and racing. By participating, you're not just investing in the current event but also shaping a resilient future for cross-country skiing in our province. Thank you for being part of this vision.

River Bend Facility Trail Fees - only U12 and up

River Bend charges a \$5.00 facility fee per day for each participating athlete. These fees go directly to River Bend for trail grooming, maintenance and use of the facility per race day. No trail fees are charged for Friday's Fun Race.

REFUND POLICY

If an event is canceled, we will follow the Nordiq Alberta Refund Policy that can be found on page 17 and 18 of the technical package which can be read <u>HERE</u>.

A refund of individual registration fees will only be provided if the Competition Secretary receives notification prior to the registration deadline of Tuesday, February 11, 2025 at midnight. After the registration deadline, no refunds will be provided except for event cancellation.

LICENSES

All competitors skiing in U14 and older categories must have at least one of the following licenses:

- Nordiq Canada Race License (U16+) New for this season Master skiers who wish to collect Master's Ranking List points must have this license.
- Nordiq Canada Associate License (foreign racers who do not belong to a NC club)
- Nordig Canada Development License (U14 and under if CPL points desired see NC website)

- Nordiq Canada Event License (U14+) This \$6 license was formerly the Supporting Member Day License (SMDL) and is charged automatically during registration if no other license number is supplied.

For Saturday and Sunday races, cross-country ski club athletes U12 category and younger do not require a license of any type, but do require a valid club membership.

All competitors, regardless of age or other Nordiq Canada race licenses held, will have to pay the new Tier 3 event license of \$3 only for the Friday Night Lights event which is included in the race fees when you register. See Nordiq Canada's explanation of Tier 3 licensing here.

Any athlete, of any age, from other Nordic disciplines including Biathlon or Nordic Combined, that are not members of a Nordiq Alberta club, must have a valid Nordiq Canada Race or Event license to compete.

Associate License for non-Canadian Skiers: For non-Canadian skiers, an Associate License may be obtained through Nordiq Canada for eligibility in all sanctioned competitions in Canada. The results of skiers with Associate Licenses will be included in the Canada Point List calculation and used for seeding purposes. For more information, visit the Nordiq Canada website.

If you do not have a current FIS, Nordiq Canada, or Nordiq Canada Associate Member Licence and are registering in U14+ categories, a daily fee will be automatically added for an Event License (formerly SMDL)

Please make sure you have renewed/purchased your license(s) for this year <u>HERE</u> prior to registering.

COACHES

Coaches are allowed on foot on the course during the race but not in the stadium. Please <u>register</u>, at no cost, to provide us with your contact information. See the QR code below for access to the AB Cup 2025/2026 Coaches WhatsApp chat group through which we will be doing the bulk of our communication. <u>Register</u> again as a racer to race in Friday Night Lights!

U18, U20, Open, CCUNC, Masters (31 and older), Para Nordic and Recreational - category medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd for each of Men, Women and Non-Binary (Recreational category)

PROTESTS

The protest procedure is outlined in the <u>Nordiq Canada Official Protest Form</u> that will include a \$100 Protest Fee. The protest fee will be returned if the protest is ruled to be valid.

SELECTION

This competition is part of the AB Cup provincial race series. It also serves as a selection event for: Alberta Ski Team (AST - criteria <u>HERE</u>), Alberta Development Ski Team (ADST - criteria <u>HERE</u>) and the Alberta Travel Team trip to Europe (criteria <u>HERE</u>).

WARM UP AND WAX TESTING

Warm up and wax testing zones will be held on the driving range to the EAST of the Clubhouse. See the course maps section of the website for more details.

ALBERTA CUP WAX PROTOCOL

TRIAL RUN FOR GLIDE WAX PILOT PROTOCOL (All participants race on the same glide wax) We will be trialling a new glide waxing protocol to keep coaches out coaching with athletes and not in the wax room. Coaches, please check the What'sApp group for information regarding details. This is intended to be a positive experience to focus on racing and race prep instead of waxing. Glide wax (Star Med or Star Polar- both buff on application) will be chosen by Nordiq Alberta 3 days in advance (December 14,, 2025) of the AB Cup 3& 4 based on the forecast. Prepare skis any way you like as a base layer, but the final layer will be the same for all racers on the day. Grip wax protocol will remain the same, so please bring your grip waxes and test away!

Nordic Alberta respectfully requests all coaches, athletes, wax technicians, and parents to abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for identified races taking place in Alberta. This also applies to coaches, athletes, wax technicians, and parents traveling to Alberta from out-of-province or out-of-country.

Waxing protocol:

- Structure tools ARE permitted.
- Non-fluoro (NF) waxes ARE permitted.
- Fluorinated waxes or tuning products containing fluorine liquid are NOT permitted at Alberta Cups for ALL age categories. This includes all types of fluorinated glide wax (e.g., LF, HF, block, powder, liquid, or kick wax). Occasionally an Alberta Cup may be run in conjunction with a FIS Cup, NorAm, or other FIS sanctioned event. For more information on the Nordiq Canada Fluoro Policy, click HERE

No external power is located on site. Please bring a generator for your waxing needs. A limited number of waxing spaces will be available on the NORTH WEST side of the parking lot. Please advise the organizing committee of your space requirements during the online registration.
